The Role of KSU as an Inclusive Innovation Hub for Kentucky

"Most people are familiar with the traditional centers of university-based innovation and entrepreneurship such as the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) and its connection to the Greater Boston entrepreneurship ecosystem. But over the last decade, more universities, community colleges, Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HCBU), and regional state colleges have embraced innovation and entrepreneurship as critical to their mission and role in their communities."

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Commonwealth of Kentucky has made tremendous advances in the development and growth of its innovation economy. Over the past decade, Kentucky has leveraged its creative, research, and entrepreneurial assets to drive innovation in the bluegrass state.

However, a vibrant environment for innovation requires a sustained approach that expands and reframes the innovation process with a greater emphasis on **inclusion**.

An *inclusive innovation* approach encourages an intentional focus on diverse, often underrepresented stakeholders, resources, and structures to create a unique ecosystem for innovation. More communities and enterprises are adopting this practice and are working with **Historically Black Colleges and Universities** (HBCUs) to increase the quantity and quality of the economic, social, or environmental outcomes beyond what would otherwise have occurred.

In the Commonwealth of Kentucky, cultivating a more inclusive ecosystem for innovation is essential to driving social impact, maintaining competitiveness, and ensuring opportunities for all Kentuckians. The University of Kentucky (UK) has taken a leading role in the state's innovation efforts through its Office of Technology Commercialization (OTC). The OTC supports UK's strategic plan by committing to:

- help build Kentucky's innovation ecosystem and collaborate with industry partners worldwide
- work cooperatively with innovators to strategically assess, protect, and license earlystage technologies
- cultivate entrepreneurship and co-create technology startups

As the only public, historically Black land-grant institution in the state, Kentucky State University (KSU) has an essential role to play in assisting the commonwealth in these ongoing efforts.

This document provides a glimpse into the commonwealth's current standing as it relates to inclusive innovation and offers context for promoting and positioning KSU as a resource for innovative industry and workforce partnerships. Also included is a summary of select HBCU-powered innovation ecosystems and recommendations for developing a **strategic roadmap** for an inclusive innovation initiative at KSU.

THE KSU INITIATIVE

From **Garrett Morgan**'s inventions of the gas mask and three-position traffic signal; to the pneumatic device for firing torpedoes underwater patented by **Henrietta Mahim Bradberry**, Kentucky's rich heritage of innovation includes bluegrass-born inventors, entrepreneurs, and social advocates of color.

Through the ingenuity of trailblazing Black businesses like the historic **Hotel Metropolitan** (1908) and the **Mammoth Life and Accident Insurance Company** (1915-92), and the historic work of social change agents such as KSU Alumnus **Whitney M. Young Jr**., Kentucky serves as fertile ground for diverse home-grown innovators.

Kentucky State University seeks to increase the yield of this fertile ground via the development of an **inclusive innovation initiative.** The intent of the initiative is to advance inclusive innovation across campus, in the community, and beyond, in support of the ecosystem in Frankfort and the overall economy of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

Led by the KSU Office of the President in collaboration with key university stakeholders and allies, the initiative will center on four primary areas:

- Innovation Workforce Development- Empower current and future professionals with skills and expertise to meet the growing need for talent in Kentucky's innovation ecosystems by augmenting the university's platform for STEAM (Science Technology Engineering, Art, and Math) via interdisciplinary curricular activities, industry collaboration, university-led national forums, and community engagement.
- Discovery, Collaborations, and Partnerships- Create and co-create knowledge that has private and public value through collaborations and partnerships with industry, government, social enterprises, nonprofits, and other educational institutions.
- Entrepreneurship- Foster an entrepreneurial culture across campus and in the community by preparing, supporting, and promoting students/alumni in the startup innovation ecosystem.
- Community and Regional Advancement- Serve as a catalyst for change and play an active role in addressing significant and persistent economic, health, and social disparities through intentional strategies that employ KSU knowledge and expertise to experiment, innovate, and create lasting impactful solutions.

THE KSU ECOSYSTEM



KSU began as an idea on October 15, 1885, to train African American teachers for employment in Kentucky's Black elementary schools and on May 18, 1886, legislators authorized the school's creation, as the State Normal School for Colored Persons, the second state-supported institution of higher learning in Kentucky. KSU became a land-grant college in 1890, and the school produced its first graduating class of five students in the spring of that year.

KSU boasts a rich history in agriculture and is the home of the world's only full-time Pawpaw research program that studies the tropical-like fruit. Over the years KSU has evolved into a leader in fields like aquaculture and organic research. In addition to its top ranked nursing program, KSU offers course work in business, consumer sciences, humanities, STEAM, and more.

KSU is also a proud partner institution of Kentucky Commercialization Ventures (KCV), which is a public-private partnership that unites Kentucky's public higher education institutions to advance innovation, intellectual property, and collaborative commercialization statewide.

KSU will expand and leverage its robust portfolio and affiliations as part of its inclusive innovation initiative in support of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

INNOVATION IN KENTUCKY

The Commonwealth of Kentucky is building a robust statewide economy for innovation. Through the Governor's Cabinet of Economic Development and KY Innovation (also known as the Kentucky Office of Entrepreneurship and Small Business), the state has made great strides towards advancing innovation and entrepreneurship and driving social impact as evidenced by recent accomplishments.

As of this writing, the state's programs have helped over **3,000** small businesses and assisted them in raising over **\$1.5 Billion** in funding. These companies have generated over **\$5.44 Billion** in revenue and created over **12,000** jobs.

Kentucky's innovation-driven efforts have also impacted its performance in critical areas.

- According to the Kauffman Foundation, the startup early survival rate in Kentucky in 2020 was **79.09%.** The rate was higher than peer states with comparable populations, such as Oregon and Alabama, and higher than neighboring states such as Indiana and Ohio.
- The state also fared well in a 2021 study by online invoicing company Skynova, indicating the average venture capital deal value for Kentucky was **\$6 million**, doubling that of nearby Ohio.
- Kentucky scored even more wins in 2021. Waste management software giant Rubicon Technologies announced it would locate its global headquarters in Louisville, KY.
 Meanwhile, the Ford Motor Company and SK Innovation unveiled plans to develop a \$5.8 billion advanced battery manufacturing campus and create more than five thousand jobs in Glendale, KY.
- Good news also continued in 2022, as Kentucky cities marked their best-ever performances on the annual **Best of the Midwest: Startup Cities Rankings**, with Louisville ranked #13, Lexington ranked #17, and Bowling Green moving up four spots on the list to #43.

These indicators suggest that there is considerable room for Kentucky to increase the scale and impact of its efforts to improve the economic and social wellbeing of Kentuckians.

INNOVATION IN KENTUCKY | CHALLENGES ON THE HORIZON

CAPITAL: Rising interest rates, inflation, and geopolitical uncertainty has cast a pall on the U.S. economy. Innovation-focused investments thrived at the height of the COVID-19 pandemic and boomed in 2021, but their continued resilience is uncertain for 2022 and 2023, as the world meets new challenges. The first three months of 2022 marked a record high for VC dealmaking among late-stage startups, but that frantic pace has slowed.

In Kentucky, venture capital companies brought in \$27.7 million during the first quarter of 2022, according to the latest Venture Monitor report from PitchBook and the National Venture Capital Association.

ECONOMY: The cost of living has outpaced the median wage in Kentucky because of the surge in inflation. According to the Kentucky Center for Economic Policy, the east-south central states — which include Kentucky — year-over-year inflation was 8.0% in July, which was slightly down from June, but still close to the highest it has been for decades. Growth has also become less inclusive. Income inequality has been rising in the world's major economies including in the United States.

WORKFORCE: The United States faces a growing shortage of STEM professionals especially when it comes to African Americans and other minorities. A 2021 analysis by the Pew Research Center indicates that Black workers make up only 9 percent of the nation's STEM workforce. Slower population growth and aging of the current population also imply that the nation will need productivity increases to do more work in the future. Innovative technologies favoring capital and higher-level skills have contributed to a decline in labor's share of income and increased wage inequality.

In Kentucky, job quality and opportunities lag for a broad cross section of workers, including women, Black Kentuckians, those in the public sector, and rural residents according to the Kentucky Center for Economic Policy. According to Brookings Research in 2019, more than 28% of jobs in the Louisville KY region were at high-risk for automation and artificial intelligence (AI). The picture is worse for Black workers who face a 44% risk of current-task automation.

As Kentucky cannot attract enough out-of-state talent to fuel the local innovation economy, it is critical to devote more resources to cultivating inclusive ecosystems to help generate a diverse "homegrown" talent pipeline. Cultivating an inclusive innovation ecosystem is essential for the future growth and competitiveness of Kentucky's economy and overall wellbeing of its citizens.

INNOVATION ECOSYSTEMS & INCLUSIVE INNOVATION

Innovation (economic and social) is the process of creating value through ideas. Economists have calculated that approximately 50% of the increase in U.S. GDP growth is the direct result of increases in innovation. Innovation powers research and development (R&D) spending. The U.S. is the leader in R&D spending. This year U.S. R&D spending is set to reach \$600 billion, which is more than any other country in the world and more than 25% of the world's total according to the Global Innovation Index. The presence of dynamic innovation ecosystems is vital to driving R&D spending and economic growth.

INNOVATION ECOSYSTEMS

Innovation ecosystems are environments comprised of synergistic public and private interests, resources, and structures that work to create value by transforming ideas into reality. These ecosystems are where startups, researchers, and investors cluster, and where opportunities to accelerate innovation are abundant.

Given that local communities and regional economies differ from one another, so too are the form and function of each innovation ecosystem across the country. Yet all such ecosystems make use of a framework for growth that is comprised of three foundational assets that are essential to success:

- **People:** the human capital that drives ideas, investments, and impact.
- Place: the physical resources, infrastructure, and supportive spaces
- **Programs:** the organizational infrastructure that supports growth and activity

Unfortunately, low income and underrepresented Americans in urban and rural areas remain outside most innovation ecosystems. As a result, the need for talent in regional innovation ecosystems go unfulfilled and the prospect of shared prosperity and opportunities is severely limited. The cultivation of innovation ecosystems that embrace **inclusion** is critical to addressing this lingering dual challenge.

INCLUSIVE INNOVATION

Progress often results from diverse perspectives. That is, the ability to see challenges differently, is often the key to critical breakthroughs. **Inclusive Innovation** is a practice that centers equality, diversity and inclusion in the design and development of innovative ideas, products, processes, or services.

Inclusive innovation is a way to strategically expand and reframe current practices. It encourages a fundamentally different approach by providing residents with access to opportunities at the grassroots level. Social impact, coupled with market-oriented activities, emphasize regional competitiveness capable of generating prosperity.

BENEFITS

Consider the benefits of cultivating an inclusive innovation ecosystem:

- Increase the flow of innovative ideas, talent, and resources
- Unlock value from untapped ideas and overlooked markets
- Increase competitive advantages and opportunities
- Maximize social impact and economic prosperity

Innovation inclusion is not only a solution to social and economic disparities. It is also a key strategy for sparking innovative minds. Everybody everywhere deserves the opportunity to participate in, and benefit from, the growing innovation economy.

It is this sentiment that will guide KSU as it initiates its plans to cultivate an ecosystem for inclusive innovation.

HBCU INCLUSIVE INNOVATION ECOSYSTEMS

HBCUs have long served as powerful engines of ingenuity and have produced more African American engineers and medical doctors than non-HBCUs. They have provided research support, produced patents, and cultivated minority talent and entrepreneurs who contribute to local and global prosperity.

HBCU Inclusive Innovation Ecosystems combine People, Places, and Programs to support inclusive growth of their local innovation ecosystems.

The following includes a sample of HBCUs around the country that are engaged in cultivating inclusive innovation ecosystems:

✤ BOWIE STATE UNIVERSITY | Bowie, MD

The inclusive innovation ecosystem at Bowie State centers on entrepreneurship driven by the University's **Entrepreneurship Living Learning Community** (ELLC). The facility is an innovation hub providing housing for 500+ students, student businesses, makerspaces, and public retail space. The ELLC is also home to the **Entrepreneurship Innovation Center** and the **Bowie Business Innovation Center**, the first business accelerator located at a Maryland HBCU.

CLARK ATLANTA UNIVERSITY | Atlanta, GA

Clark Atlanta University (CAU) maintains an innovation and entrepreneurship-driven ecosystem that focuses on creativity, research, and social justice. CAU is the home of the nation's first business college for African Americans and its School of Business in collaboration with other leading academic units at the university leads CAU's inclusive innovation efforts.

In addition to producing leaders at the undergraduate and graduate levels, CAU cultivates nextgeneration innovators by connecting students, faculty, alumni, and allies through its **Center for Innovation and Entrepreneurial Development** (CIED), the **Clark Russell Entrepreneurship and Technology Ecosystems** (CREATE) Initiative, and the CAU Innovation Lounge. Experiential activities such as its **Forward Forum** series, **PantherBiz Expo**, and the **Dean's Executive Leader** series round out CAU's inclusive innovation ecosystem.

FLORIDA A&M STATE UNIVERSITY | Tallahassee, FL

The Florida A&M University (FAMU) Research, Entrepreneurship, and Commercialization Hub, also known as REACH, facilitates community development and create networks of support services that provide a sustainable commercialization pathway for entrepreneurs and innovators.

Additionally, the FAMU innovation ecosystem includes the Office of Technology Transfer, the School of Business and Industry's Small Business Development Center, the Center for Public Computing and Workforce Development, and the School of Architecture and Engineering Technology. The Interdisciplinary Center for Creativity and Innovation (ICCI) brings FAMU

researchers, students, and alumni together across disciplines to establish and build a climate of technology commercialization and business product.

✤ HARRIS STOWE STATE UNIVERSITY | St. Louis, MO

Harris-Stowe State University (HSSU) concentrates its ecosystem efforts around entrepreneurship. Through the University's **Anheuser-Busch School of Business**, HSSU offers stackable credentials in technology and financial disciplines and facilitates entrepreneurial activities on campus and the community via its **Minority Entrepreneurship Collaboration Center for Advancement** (MECCA) which provides educational training and services for entrepreneurs; and the new **HSSU's Center for Innovation & Entrepreneurship** (CIE) which will serve as a hub for innovation, entrepreneurship, and partnerships to enhance the black/brown community as well as the community at large.

MORGAN STATE UNIVERSITY | Baltimore, MD

In the future, Morgan State University plans to turn a former East Baltimore high school into an **innovation park and satellite campus**. The 59-acre property known as Lake Clifton high school will serve as the home for researchers and startup companies that grow out of Morgan State. The university's ecosystem will soon add health innovations to its portfolio. Morgan State is moving forward with plans to establish a new, for-private medical school on the site of the former Montebello Hospital Complex. The University hopes to welcome the first students into the new school in 2024.

These announcements align with the current in-class instruction at Morgan State, which includes start-up development, business accelerator, social entrepreneurship, entrepreneurship opportunity recognition, and more. The university's **Entrepreneurial Center** also offers a variety of educational events on campus, has a podcast, and hosts webinars. These developments will augment the university's current course offerings which include start up development, business accelerator, social entrepreneurship, entrepreneurship opportunity, recognition and more. The university's Entrepreneurial Center also offers a variety of educational events on campus, has its own podcast, and host webinars.

NORTH CAROLINA A&T STATE UNIVERSITY | Greensboro, NC

Among HBCUs, North Carolina A&T State University (NC A&T) offers the best example of a comprehensive ecosystem for inclusive innovation. The University has created three new Centers of Excellence in cybersecurity, advanced manufacturing, and entrepreneurship and innovation.

NC A&T will also be the first HBCU in the United States to host a **national Agriculture Business Innovation Center** that will help underserved populations. The U.S. Department of Agriculture awarded \$1.92 million to the NC A&T College of Agriculture and Environmental Sciences to establish the center. The University's expansive innovation portfolio also includes:

- The Aggie Venture Development Lab: an incubator for students interested in entrepreneurship and innovation. Students have 24-hour access to a shared facility, mentoring, workshops, and business service providers (such as accountants, lawyers, and graphic designers with small business experience). The Lab also has a funding source called The Aggie Start Up Fund which provides cash awards to seed startup businesses for participants who reach certain milestones within the Startup Lab program.
- NC A&T University Research Farm: a 492-acre working, producing farm that raises crops and livestock, and serves as the university's largest classroom and largest laboratory. Founded in 1902, the farm is home to the recently opened Extension and Research Farm Pavilion and is part of the institution's College of Agriculture and Environmental Sciences (CAES).
- Gateway University Research Park: a collaboration between NC A&T and The University of North Carolina Greensboro (UNCG). This unique joint venture seeks to transform intellectual properties into thriving businesses in a collaborative environment that combines groundbreaking business organizations with world-class laboratories, highly advanced equipment, and the intellectual capital of faculty and students from both institutions.

TENNESSEE STATE UNIVERSITY | Nashville, TN

Tennessee State University (TSU) is building an inclusive ecosystem for innovation through its Center for Entrepreneurship and Economic Development (CEED), which coordinates the entrepreneurship efforts of the University, the TSU Incubation Center, and the Small Business Development Center (SBDC).

Adding to this ecosystem is TSU's National Center for SMART Technology Innovations. The Center's mission is to address educational and workforce challenges through the innovative development of 'App' technology. The Center serves as home to technology initiatives that seek to bring coding and creativity (known as C2) experiences to HBCUs and the Nashville community.

Looking towards the future, TSU plans to expand its inclusive innovation ecosystem with the development of a mixed-use **Research and Innovation District** along the west side of the TSU campus. The proposed 70-acre project will introduce opportunities for economic development and business incubation, innovation research and education, workforce housing, commercial activities, and more.

As is evident in the above, HBCUs are serving as powerful engines of inclusive innovation. **KSU** aspires to accomplish the same in support of the innovation economy in the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

THE ROAD AHEAD

Kentucky State University believes that diversity of innovative ideas, talents, solutions, and opportunities are the key drivers of the innovation economy. This belief aligns with KSU's commitment to advancing the Commonwealth of Kentucky, enhancing society, and impacting individuals by providing quality teaching with a foundation in liberal studies, scholarly research, and public service. It also aligns with Kentucky's **60x30** <u>strategic agenda</u> for postsecondary education to advance the Commonwealth to accelerate job creation, grow the economy, and expand the tax base through the contributions of a more skilled, productive workforce.

KSU envisions that cultivating an inclusive innovation ecosystem focused on **innovation workforce development; discovery, collaborations, and partnerships; entrepreneurship; and community and regional advancement** can play a critical role in support of the overall economy of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.



- Although the state is improving, recent data points indicate that there is considerable room for Kentucky to increase the scale and impact of its efforts to improve the economic competitiveness, future growth, and prosperity through a KSU inclusive innovation initiative.
- HBCUs are successfully cultivating inclusive innovation ecosystems in communities and at enterprises across the country.
- As an HBCU, land grant, and regional institution, KSU stands ready to do its part in support of the innovation economy of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
- KSU proposes to launch an Inclusive Innovation Initiative that augments its current ecosystem and assists in ensuring that all Kentuckians can participate and prosper in the commonwealth's innovation economy.

KENTUCKY STATE UNIVERSITY: INSIGHTS ON INCLUSIVE INNOVATION

RECOMMENDATIONS

To increase KSU's contribution to the economic and social growth and development of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, it is essential that the university take steps to memorialize its commitment to serving an Inclusive Innovation Hub for Kentucky by establishing this initiative as the core objective of its long-term strategic pathway. This will require the development of a strategic roadmap that addresses the following questions:

- What outcomes do we want KSU to deliver as part of Kentucky's innovation economy ten or more years from now?
- What will need to change to fulfill this vision in the intermediate term?
- To obtain the desired intermediate outcomes, what are the required short-term outcomes?
- To deliver the short-term outcomes what are the required outputs?
- To produce the needed outputs, what are the required programs and initiatives and inputs?



STRATEGIC ROAD MAP

The specific purpose of a strategic roadmap is to align KSU's proposed inclusive innovation initiative toward common goals, including efforts currently underway with respect to the KSU management improvement plan. At a minimum, the strategic roadmap should include:

- Inventory Assessment to understand where KSU has been and what it is doing now as it relates to the state of its inclusive innovation ecosystem.
- Analysis of opportunities and challenges facing KSU within a statewide, national, and global context.
- Analysis of how to maximize KSU's current Discovery Portfolio (research, student, and alumni) development derived from local industry, university, and federal agency assets.
- Analysis of the existing regional ecosystems in the commonwealth that supports innovation.
- Recommendations to build a more inclusive ecosystem focused on innovation, including regional growth strategies that consider quality of place, underrepresented innovators, and underserved populations.
- Recommendations on the strategic framework and messaging (vision/mission/branding) for the KSU Inclusive Innovation Initiative.
- Identification of prospective partnerships and potential opportunities for clustering in business, research, and emerging technologies.
- Recommendations of how the philanthropic community can invest in KSU resources (financial, human capital, and others) needed to grow the inclusive innovation economy.
- Recommend statewide incentives or program designs to encourage entrepreneurship for the support of business creation, growth and/or relocation in the innovation economy.
- Short-term, mid-term, and long-term action steps.

Kentucky State University needs a professional firm's assistance in hiring and training staff members who will perform various accounting, budgetary, payroll, data processing, purchasing, and other procedural and internal control-related activities. The University also lacks the competencies to prepare monthly bank reconciliations and forecasts on cash flows, budget executions, and key performance indices.

Kentucky State University requests approval to enter into a contract with YPTC consulting firm.

BUDGETARY IMPLICATIONS:

The Council on Postsecondary Education has earmarked consulting services funds of \$500,000 in its Management Improvement Plan. The University estimates that the total costs of services will amount to between \$250,000 and \$300,000.

RECOMMENDATION:

Interim President Ronald A. Johnson recommends that the Board of Regents approves the YPTC personal services contract.

BUDGETARY IMPLICATIONS:

The total contract amount is \$235,200. Capital Plaza Hotel will provide 160 rooms for students. Each room will cost \$49 per day, and the contract's term is for the thirty-day period between January 6, 2023 and February 6, 2023.

Interim President Ronald A. Johnson recommends that the Board of Regents approves the Capital Plaza Hotel contract.

All rooms provided will be non-smoking. All rooms provided will have Wi-Fi access. Kentucky State University will inspect each room prior to the student's arrival/departure. Any damages will be the financial responsibility of Kentucky State University.

Capital Plaza is operating as a hotel and students will be expected to refrain from activity that would negatively impact the hotel and/or KSU while on hotel premises. Parties and excessive noise will not be allowed. Kentucky State University Security will be utilized for any student issues.

If Kentucky State University must close due to the Covid-19 pandemic, the Capital Plaza Hotel will release Kentucky State University from any obligation to make additional payments under the terms of this contract as soon as the student has vacated the room including taking of all personal belongings.

Vacuum cleaners and cleaning products will be available at the front desk. Onsite maintenance is available until 11 pm and on call for any emergencies. Indoor pool, if open, is available from 7am-11pm and all pool rules will be adhered to or privileges will be revoked. There will be no offset of room rental in the event of pool closure.

This contract is subject to the terms and conditions stated herein. Stakeholder Agreement

This Stakeholder Agreement, dated October 25, 2022 ("Agreement"), is between Kentucky State University located at 400 East Main Street, Frankfort, KY and the University of Kentucky Research Foundation, located at 109 Kinkead Hall Lexington, KY 40506-0057 on behalf of the Kentucky Small Business Development Center State Office ("KSBDC"), located at 330 East Main Street, Suite 210, Lexington, KY 40507 (collectively, the "Parties").

Recitals

WHEREAS, The KSBDC received funding from the U.S. Small Business Administration ("SBA") Office of Small Business Development Centers to support consulting and training services for small businesses in Kentucky ("SBA Funding"); and

WHEREAS, The Parties believe that business coaching helps advance the parties' mutual goal to provide valuable economic development assistance services to existing businesses and entrepreneurs in Kentucky; and

WHEREAS, The Parties desire to enter into an agreement to utilize a portion of the SBA Funding to engage one full-time KSBDC business coach to provide coaching, consulting, advising, counseling and training services to start-up businesses, existing businesses and entrepreneurs in an area including, but not limited to: Anderson County, Frankfort County, Henry County, Owen County, Shelby County, and Spencer County; and

WHEREAS, The Parties understand that all activities supported by the funds provided pursuant to this Agreement shall be in compliance with the KSBDC and SBA guidelines, policies and procedures; and

WHEREAS, The Parties understand and agree that the KSBDC business coach(es) would also be available to perform professional activities for Parties which are not inconsistent with the performance of services required by this Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE the Parties agree as follows;

ARTICLE I -TERM

1.1 This Agreement shall become effective upon the date of execution by both parties and continue in effect until November 30, 2023, or until it is replaced or canceled pursuant to Article V.

ARTICLE II - TERMS OF PAYMENT

- 2.1 KSU shall provide Cash Match support to the University of Kentucky Research Foundation, who represents KSBDC, in the amount \$50,000 to support the services of KSBDC business coach(es) in the region and in support of the KSBDC statewide initiative.
- 2.2 Kentucky SBDC agrees to submit progress reports on a quarterly basis to KSU. All reports will be addressed to KSU, 400 East Main Street, Frankfort, KY.



2.3 KSU shall disburse the funds to the Kentucky SBDC in one lump sum payment of \$50,000 ("Funds"), and shall be made upon execution of this agreement.

ARTICLE III - RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE STAKEHOLDER

- 3.1 KSU agrees to contribute \$50,000 towards the salaries of KSBDC business coach(es) who shall collaborate with the Consortium and represent KSBDC throughout the region.
- 3.2 KSU shall permit the KSBDC business coach(es) to represent KSBDC throughout Kentucky. KSBDC is a statewide network and, as such, all business coach(es) are expected to serve the statewide network.
- 3.3 KSU and KSBDC shall share oversight responsibilities of the KSBDC business coach(es) performance during the term of this Agreement. KSBDC will regularly monitor the KSBDC business coach(es) performance and provide the KSU regular input on that performance as it relates to the services to be provided under this Agreement.
- 3.4 KSU shall immediately contact KSBDC if it desires to terminate its relationship with the KSBDC business coach(es) prior to the end of the Term of this Agreement.
- 3.5 KSU shall provide in-kind investments to support the KSBDC Office and Business Coach(es) in the region. The investments described will be made available to the KSBDC between the dates of 10/01/2022 and 09/30/2023. No expectation of compensation in return for the investments described below such as a requirement that the investment(s) be made as a provision in a contract or purchase order.

- 3.6 KSU shall return any equipment provided to the KSBDC business coach(es) by KSBDC under paragraph 4.2 immediately upon expiration or cancellation of this Agreement or termination of the KSBDC business coach(es) unless otherwise agreed by KSBDC.
- 3.7 All physical, computerized, electronic or other types of records, documents, notes, lists, files and any and all other materials including but not limited to computerized or electronic information that refers, relates or otherwise pertains to the KSBDC and any individual or entity that received services under this Agreement shall be returned to KSBDC immediately upon the expiration or cancellation of this Agreement or termination of the KSBDC business coach(es).



- 3.8 Any and all documentation, data, reports and any other writing or information prepared or assembled for the purposes of this Agreement are considered confidential and may only be shared during the term of this Agreement and with prior written approval of the KSBDC.
- 3.9 This Agreement does not supersede or alter any current contracts between the Parties.

ARTICLE IV - RESPONSIBILITIES OF KSBDC

- 4.1 The KSBDC shall provide the KSBDC business coach(es) with the necessary training, information, access and materials to perform the services identified in this Agreement.
- 4.2 The KSBDC shall provide KSBDC business coach(es) with such additional equipment the KSBDC business coach(es) will require to perform his/her/their duties under this Agreement not available under paragraph 3.7 of this Agreement, subject to KSBDC's sole discretion that such equipment is necessary to carry out the purposes of this Agreement.
- 4.3 The KSBDC shall provide the KSBDC business coach(es) with copies of comparable production reports, along with regular guidance and oversight related to their performance of services identified in this Agreement.
- 4.4 The KSBDC will pay KSBDC business coach{es} for the services identified in this Agreement as set forth in Article II of this Agreement.

ARTICLE V -CONTINUATION AND CANCELLATION

5.1 KSU and the KSBDC State Director will meet within 30 days prior to November 30, 2023 to review the work completed and continuation of the Agreement. Any agreement to extend this Agreement must be in writing and signed by all Parties.

ARTICLE VI - MISCELLANEOUS

- 6.1 This Agreement, with Attachments I and II, embraces the promises, agreements, conditions, and understandings between the Parties hereto, and there are no promises, conditions, covenants or understandings between the Parties hereto except such as are specified herein in writing between KSBDC and KSU.
- 6.2 This Agreement may be modified and changed only by an instrument in writing signed by the undersigned Parties.
- 6.3 If any part of this Agreement is found to be null and void, or is otherwise stricken, the rest of this Agreement shall remain in force.
- 6.4 The titles to the articles and paragraphs of the Agreement are solely for the convenience of the Parties and shall not be used to explain, modify, simplify, or aid in the interpretation of the provisions of this Agreement.



Confidentiality and Dissemination of Information

Unless otherwise specified, all financial, statistical, personnel and/or technical data which is furnished, produced or otherwise available to KSBDC business coach(es) during performance of this Agreement is considered privileged information and shall not be used or released by without prior written consent of the KSBDC State Office. Statistical use of such information that does not identify individual clients may be used by KSBDC business coach(es) and the South Central Consortium, and does not require prior approval by the KSBDC State Office.

The KSBDC Outreach Office will conform to the revised SBA reporting and record keeping requirements as follows:

The KSBDC business coach(es) agree to maintain complete and accurate records and supporting documentation to support and facilitate any financial and/or program audit. Further, the KSBDC business coach(es) shall be prepared to furnish such records for any and all audit reviews.

- a. KSBDC Business Coach{es)
 - SBA Form 641(a) shall be used to report and document SBDC Consulting/Counseling/Coaching activity. Form 641(a) may be maintained in electronic form, and a hard copy is also recommended.
 - 2. Consulting/Counseling/Coaching cases are those which have been provided one-half (1/2) or more hours of Consulting and support activity.
 - 3. The KSBDC business coach(es) will maintain individual files on each KSBDC client, including documentation necessary to provide a clear audit trail.
- b. Training:
 - 1. SBA Form 888 shall be used to report and document SBDC training activity. Each KSBDC business coach(es) shall report the number of SBA approved training programs, the number of attendees, and the attendee demographic data as specified on the reverse of SBA Form 888.
 - 2. Only those training programs approved by SBA and conducted during the budget period of this Agreement are to be applied.

Approval to submit an RFP to secure the services of a consulting firm for the development and implementation of the Inclusive Innovation project.

FACTS:

To further develop and eventually implement the University's Inclusive Innovation project, the services of a consulting firm are required. The University's leadership will work with the consulting firm to ensure that the project is developed with significant input from the University's Board members, faculty members, staff members, and students, as well as important external stakeholders.

To secure the services of a consulting firm, the University requests the Board's approval to issue a Request for Proposal (RFP).

BUDGETARY IMPLICATIONS:

The University is requesting permission to use Title III funding to secure the services of a consulting firm that will be selected through a competitive bid process. The anticipated cost of the firm's services is not to exceed \$150,000.

RECOMMENDATION:

Interim President Ronald A. Johnson recommends that the Board of Regents approves the University's request to issue an RFP.

MOTION:

Approve the University's request to issue an RFP to secure the services of a consulting firm for the development and implementation of the Inclusive Innovation project.
