

Kentucky State University Statement of Student Financial Responsibility

*When registering for the first time for a semester
the following statement will need to be affirmed.*

Kentucky State University's official method of correspondence with students is via the kysu.edu assigned email address. I understand that I am responsible for regularly (not less than once per week) accessing my KSU assigned email account and for taking any required action indicated in official university correspondence sent to this address.

STUDENT FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

I understand registration constitutes a contractual financial obligation to pay tuition and fees for which I am liable. I understand my financial obligations are due by the semester due date. Information regarding the semester due date and payment options is available on the Bursar website.

I am responsible for reading and understanding the current Tuition Reduction Schedule policy of the University as it appears on kysu.edu: Current Students > Tuition & Fees > How do I pay my bill?

Permission to cancel enrollment does not constitute, nor shall it be construed as, a waiver by KSU, of my financial obligation. I understand any financial assistance I receive will be applied against my billed charges to reduce my financial obligation. I am responsible for all outstanding debts and contracts with the University. Federal regulations prohibit federal financial aid from paying non-mandatory university charges unless you, the student, provide your authorization to do so.

Upon withdrawal, I will contact the Bursar's Office by mail or email to determine what amount remains outstanding on my account.

Students with unpaid account balances will be placed on Financial Hold by the Bursar's Office. Students placed on Financial Hold become ineligible for further registration and transcripts will not be released until the student's account is paid in full. A late Payment Fee may be assessed when a student's account balance is not paid by the last day to drop/add.

By registering for one or more classes for the 2022-2023 academic year, I agree to pay any and all charges on my student account. I promise to pay Kentucky State University the full amount of the obligation by the due date. I also understand and agree to pay any and all fees incurred should I default on my student account, including the fees of any collection agency. Should my failure to pay result in litigation, I agree to pay the attorney fees which may be based on a percentage of the debt. I also understand that once my account is sent to a collection agency, interest may be charged to the outstanding balance including fees. I have also reviewed the refund deadlines found at <https://www.kysu.edu/finance-and-administration/bursar/how-do-i-pay-my-bill.php> prior to dropping a class and I understand that I may be responsible for fees associated with class withdrawal if I fall below full time status.

I understand and agree my financial obligation to Kentucky State University constitutes an educational loan to assist in financing my education and therefore is not dischargeable, pursuant to United States Bankruptcy Code section 523 (a) (8).

In addition, I authorize Kentucky State University and their respective agents or contracted vendors to contact me regarding my loan or student account balance including repayment of my loan or student account balance, at the current or any future number that I provide for my cellular phone or other wireless device using automated telephone dialing equipment or artificial or pre-recorded voice or text messages.

This Agreement shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
