Kentucky State University Statement of Student Financial Responsibility

Fall 2026 Semester

When registering for the Fall 2026 semester, the following statement must be electronically affirmed.

Kentucky State University's official method of correspondence with students is the University-assigned kysu.edu email address. I understand that I am responsible for regularly, but no less than once per week, accessing my University-assigned email account and taking any required action indicated in official University correspondence sent to this address.

I further affirm that the full record of my financial obligations is reflected on my student account statement located in my WIRED portal. I agree to regularly check my WIRED account for an accurate billing and payment statement.

STUDENT FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

I understand that registration constitutes a contractual financial obligation to pay tuition and fees for which I am liable. I understand that my financial obligations are due by the semester due date. Information regarding the semester due date and payment options is available on the [Student Accounts webpages](#).

I am responsible for reading and understanding the current Tuition Reduction Schedule policy of the University as it appears on the [How Do I Pay My Bill?](#) webpage.

Permission to cancel enrollment does not constitute, nor shall it be construed as, a waiver by Kentucky State University of my financial obligation. I understand that any financial assistance I receive will be applied against my billed charges to reduce my financial obligation. I am responsible for all outstanding debts and contracts with the University.

Federal regulations prohibit federal financial aid from paying nonmandatory University charges unless I, the student, provide authorization to do so.

Upon withdrawal, I will contact the Student Accounts Office by mail or at StudentAccounts@kysu.edu to determine what amount remains outstanding on my account.

Students with unpaid account balances will be placed on financial hold by the Student Accounts Office. Students placed on financial hold become ineligible for further registration, and transcripts will not be released until the student's account is paid in full. A late-payment fee may be assessed when a student's account balance is not paid by the last day to add or drop a class.

By registering for one or more classes for the Fall 2026 semester, I agree to pay any and all charges on my student account. I promise to pay Kentucky State University the full amount of the obligation by the due date. I also understand and agree to pay any and all fees incurred should I default on my student account, including the fees of any collection agency. Should my failure to pay result in litigation, I agree to pay the attorney fees, which may be based on a percentage of the debt. I also understand that once my account is sent to a collection agency, interest may be charged on the outstanding balance, including fees.

I have also reviewed the refund deadlines found on the [How Do I Pay My Bill?](#) webpage before dropping a class, and I understand that I may be responsible for fees associated with class withdrawal if I fall below full-time status.

I understand and agree that my financial obligation to Kentucky State University constitutes an educational loan to assist in financing my education and therefore is not dischargeable pursuant to Section 523(a)(8) of the United States Bankruptcy Code.

In addition, I authorize Kentucky State University and its respective agents or contracted vendors to contact me regarding my loan or student account balance, including repayment of my loan or student account balance, at the current or any future number I provide for my cellular telephone or other wireless device using automated telephone-dialing equipment or artificial or prerecorded voice or text messages.

This agreement shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
