**REGULATION STATEMENT:**

Kentucky State University (KSU) encourages high standards of academic excellence and formally acknowledges outstanding student achievement. This regulation outlines the criteria for semester-based honors (Dean's List and Academic Honor Roll) and for honors awarded upon graduation (Cum Laude, Magna Cum Laude, Summa Cum Laude, Valedictorian, and Salutatorian).

**DEFINITIONS:**

**Academic Honor Roll**

An academic honor awarded to part-time students who achieve a high GPA in a given semester.

**Cum Laude**

An honor awarded upon graduation signifying "with praise."

### **Dean's List**

An academic honor awarded to full-time students who achieve a high GPA in a given semester.

### **Graduation Honors**

Honors awarded at the time of graduation based on a student's final cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA).

### **Magna Cum Laude**

An honor awarded upon graduation signifying "with great praise."

### **Salutatorian**

The baccalaureate degree candidate with the second-highest academic standing in the graduating class.

### **Summa Cum Laude**

An honor awarded upon graduation signifying "with highest praise."

### **Valedictorian**

The baccalaureate degree candidate with the highest academic standing in the graduating class.

## **PROCESS:**

### **Semester Honors**

- **Dean's List:** To be included on the Dean's List for a semester, a student must meet the following criteria:
  - Earn 12 or more semester credit hours for which quality points are awarded.
  - Achieve a grade point average of 3.2 or better for that semester.
- **Academic Honor Roll:** To be included on the Academic Honor Roll for a semester, a student must meet the following criteria:
  - Be enrolled in 6 to 11 semester credit hours for which quality points are awarded.
  - Achieve a grade point average of 3.2 or better for that semester.

### **Graduation Honors**

Graduation honors are awarded to graduating baccalaureate degree students based on their final cumulative GPA as calculated from all coursework attempted at KSU.

- **Summa Cum Laude:** To graduate Summa Cum Laude, a student must have a final cumulative GPA of 3.80 or higher.
- **Magna Cum Laude:** To graduate Magna Cum Laude, a student must have a final cumulative GPA of at least 3.60 but less than 3.80.

- **Cum Laude:** To graduate Cum Laude, a student must have a final cumulative GPA of at least 3.40 but less than 3.60.

### **Valedictorian and Salutatorian Selection**

- **Selection:** The Valedictorian and Salutatorian are the students with the highest and second-highest cumulative GPA, respectively, in the baccalaureate graduating class.
- **Tie-Breaker:** In the event of a tie for the highest or second-highest cumulative GPA (e.g., multiple students with a 4.0 GPA), the final selection will be based on the following criteria, applied in sequential order until a distinction is made:
  - **1st Criterion:** The total number of credit hours earned with a grade of “A.”
  - **2nd Criterion:** The total number of credit hours earned at KSU.
  - **3rd Criterion:** The total number of leadership positions in extracurricular organizations.
  - **4th Criterion:** An essay contest decided by a vote by a committee composed of KSU’s Deans.
