Student Financial Responsibility and Collections

POLICY STATEMENT:

Students are responsible for settling all tuition, fees, and other charges incurred at Kentucky State University (KSU) on or before any specified deadlines. This policy establishes the framework for addressing unresolved student account balances. While many students receive financial assistance from external sources, the ultimate financial liability for all charges rests with the student.

DEFINITIONS:

Past-Due Balance

An account balance that has not been paid within thirty (30) days of a payment's due date.

Financial Hold

An administrative restriction placed on a student's account that prevents further registration and the release of official transcripts until the account is settled.

PROCESS:

Student Financial Responsibility

- Students are obligated to pay their account balances in full by the designated semester due dates.
- At the start of each semester, students will be required to sign and initial a "Statement of Student Financial Responsibility," acknowledging this obligation.

Collection of Past-Due Accounts

- KSU will take systematic action to collect all past-due student account balances.
- Accounts that remain past-due may be referred to a third-party collections agency and/or attorneys.
- In the event an account is referred for external collection, the student will be responsible for reimbursing KSU for all associated fees and costs. Such fees may be based on a percentage of the delinquent balance, up to a maximum of forty percent (40%), or the maximum permitted by law.
- KSU or its associated vendors may report information regarding unpaid obligations to credit bureaus.

<u>Implementation</u>

The specific procedures, timelines, consequences, and appeals process for managing past-due accounts are detailed in the Student Account Collections Regulation.
