

Music Education Specialization

The Music Education Specialization of the Bachelor of Music degree prepares students to seek teacher certification in grades primary-12. The Educator Preparation Program in Music has specific admissions requirements and coursework, including a semester of full-time student teaching. Students may specialize in keyboard, instrumental, or vocal music education. The degree is offered by the Division of Fine Arts in the College of Arts, Social Sciences, and Interdisciplinary Studies in conjunction with the School of Education in the College of Professional Studies and requires 120 semester credit hours. All students in the Music Education Option must enroll in and successfully complete a dual placement supervised teaching experience.
